### Final state attestation: defense of the diploma/thesis on the theme

#### Note

a) In Russian Federation (RF) the study workload is evaluated in «*academicheskie chasy*» (academic hours or AH). 1 AH = 45 minutes. Now it is possible to evaluate workload in Credits (according to the recommendation: № 14-52-988ИН/13 from 28.11.2002 of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia). 1 ECTS Credit = 36 academic hours or 27 astronomical hours.

b) 1 week of full-time study = 54 AH = 1,5 Credits

#### Grading scheme

*otlichno*» (excellent - a high level of competence);

«*khorosho*» (good – a good general performance);

«*udovletvoritelno*» (satisfactory – a fair performance);

«*neudovletvoritelno*» (poor- a poor performance);

or «*zachteno*» (passed);

«*ne zachteno*» (not passed).

The lowest passing grade is «*udovletvoritelno*» (satisfactory) and «*zachteno*»

(passed). Students are only permitted to enroll in the next year of study and

to be awarded a diploma if they have passing grades in each subject of the curriculum.
